2. Responsible for maintaining active supervision of children and fulfilling the role assigned by Center Director, or designee, to maintain daily activity and functions at all times
3. To support teaching staff with preparation of materials and activities for individuals, small and large groups of children according to curriculum
4. To attend mandatory local and out of town workshops, conferences and training sessions as required to enhance job skills

5. Responsible for attending Head Start/Early Head Start functions in which some activities may take place after Head Start/Early Head Start regular operational hours
6. Assist in collecting monthly in-kind contributions from parents, vendors, community representatives and other service providers to meet the Non-Federal Share match (preparing classroom activities, stapling copies, hand washing, tooth brushing, fixing parent and classroom boards, etc.)
7. Responsible for maintaining positive classroom interactions as it pertains to the Pre-K and Infant/Toddler Classroom Assessment Scoring System (CLASS)
8. Rides the bus on a rotating basis in the morning/afternoon or on field trips as assigned by Center Director to extend learning environment to the bus and assist as the bus monitor (only if transportation is provided)

10. Responsible for working extended day care as assigned by the Center Director (if applicable)
